

Parking Area Changes at Hospital Spaces Set Aside for Emergency Department Patients and Visitors

This week, crews began working on the next section of MCH's perimeter road (see #1 on map). This has resulted in some changes to parking and driving patterns in lots primarily used by staff. Here's what has happened and where staff and patients can park.

Parking Lots in front of the Parmelee Building

A section of the parking lot in front of the Parmelee building has been temporarily closed for construction vehicles that are working on the perimeter road.

This affects parking and driving in the following ways (please see map):

- There is now a single driving lane open for 2-way traffic to access the parking lot outside of the cafeteria.
- Parking for doctors is now limited to the rows of cars to the north of the driving lane



Emergency Department Parking

One area of the parking lot outside of the Emergency Department and near the construction trailers now has dedicated spaces for Emergency Department patients and visitors (see map).

Patient Parking

If you are visiting the Medical Arts Building or the hospital, please park in lots E, O and the lot directly in front of the Wellness Center (see map).
