Access from Rt. 202 Opens this Monday, Oct. 19th.

(See #1 on map) Beginning Monday afternoon, traffic on Route 202 will be able to enter our campus via the new town connector road named, "Parmelee Drive." All cars arriving via this new road will pass through the newly opened town rotary. (See #2 on map). Entering our campus from Parmelee Drive will require driving 3/4's of the way around the rotary.

Access from Old Street Road into Town Rotary opens this Monday, Oct. 19th.

(See #3 on map) All traffic driving on

Old Street Road will now pass through the newly opened town rotary, beginning Monday afternoon, Oct 19th. Currently, a dirt section of road allows traffic on Old Street Road to bypass the town rotary. On Monday, this dirt section of road will close. This represents a major traffic pattern change. Please plan to drive carefully through this area for the next few weeks as everyone becomes familiar with this change.

Bond Wellness Center (See #4 on map) This section of the project will remain very busy for the next few weeks. The new section of roadway for the South Perimeter Road will be opening, allowing for smoother travel to and from these parking lots. All of the traffic islands in front of the Main Hospital entrance (including the circular island) will be removed as paving and parking are reconfigured throughout this area. Please continue to use care when driving or walking through this section and encourage others to do so. Sidewalks and signage are being installed to improve pedestrian access through this busy area of the work zone. Additional patient parking signs will be installed in the Wellness Center parking lot to ensure ongoing availability of patient parking in this area.
