Over the next month, construction will continue in the same areas and at the same pace it has for the past four weeks. There will be no major changes to the campus or driving patterns at this time. Below is a recap of the construction that will be continuing along with a peek at the changes that will be coming in May and June.

Generator Building

Work continues on the inside of the generator building (located behind the cafeteria). The floors have been poured. Over the next few weeks, the electrical piping will be installed. Holes are being dug in preparation for fuel tanks to power the generators when needed.

Safety Note

With continued construction we ask that you remain alert and drive slowly and carefully on the hospital grounds. Please be patient and courteous with others who are driving slowly and avoid tailgating. Remember, safety comes first. In addition, watch for construction vehicles and avoid following closely behind them. Flagmen will be present when needed to help safely direct traffic.

MCH Perimeter Road and Roundabout

- Crews are continuing work on the roundabout at MCH's current street entrance and perimeter road.
- If you look over the jersey barriers to your right upon entering the campus (please be careful if you are driving and looking!), you will notice that the roundabout has been cleared.
- We hope to open the roundabout and adjoining perimeter road on the north side of the campus in late spring. Stay tuned for more updates on this next month!

Parking Lots

- As mentioned last month, the new lot E (next to Lot O) was opened for staff parking.
- Parking should remain the same for the next month.
- In May and June, there will be temporary changes to the parking lots that will affect where staff and patients can park. Portions of some lots will temporarily close and others will temporarily open. We will inform you and the public in early May, when we know exactly what those changes will be so that you can plan accordingly.

Town Connector Road and Roundabout

- The roadway has been cleared. Over the next month, construction crews will continue preparing the ground for the connector road and roundabout at the new campus entrance.
- During that time, they will be developing the layout of the roundabout and new access at Old Street Road. The Town is currently on schedule to complete this project in the fall.

Old Street Road Closure

The Town of Peterborough has closed Old Street Road from Route 101 to Sand Hill Road in order to upgrade water mains. Although this closure is not related to the Hospital or connector road projects, it does affect travel routes for staff and patients. The closure may be as long as two months. We have asked the Town's Department of Public Works to place more "detour" signs on the roads to help patients and visitors access the hospital. Please be aware of this change and inform your patients as well. and plantings will be added to the new lot by the fall.
