MCH in the Community

Giving back to the community has always been a priority at Monadnock Community Hospital. It's our goal to make the Monadnock Region a healthier place to live by identifying new and changing health care needs and providing innovative solutions. In 2006, MCH's Community Benefits Plan provided \$2,667,866 in free or reduced-fee services and programs to thousands of families and individuals in the community.

Monadnock Healthy Teeth

MCH's comprehensive school-based dental program, Monadnock Healthy Teeth, was started in 2003 and has grown to include every grade school in the ConVal, Jaffrey-Rindge and Mascenic school districts. The MHT program is also in a number of area pre-schools and Head Start programs. In 2006, MHT brought together local

dentists, dental hygienists, schools and the non-profit community to ensure that more than 1,700 students were educated about the basics of good dental care and had access to important dental services.

Financial Grant Program

The Hospital's Financial Grant Program, the largest and most critical outreach program, is administered by the Social Services Department. This department also helps families and individuals in need with access to health care and other available community services such as

catastrophic care, fuel assistance, Meals on Wheels, food banks, and visiting nurses. Social Services also works closely with New Hampshire Healthy Kids, which provides low-cost

or free health coverage for uninsured children. In 2006, MCH provided \$1,472,840 in financial assistance to families and individuals in the community. This was an increase of 148% over the financial assistance provided in 2005. An income sliding scale is used to determine eligibility, with discounts ranging from 25% to 100%.

Medication Bridge

Started in 2002, MCH's Medication Bridge Program provided \$619,214 in reduced or no-cost prescription medications to under-insured and uninsured patients with chronic medical conditions. In 2006, hundreds of active patients were provided medications through this program. Additionally, the Medication Bridge Program coordinator worked closely with many senior citizens to help them with the necessary paper work for the new Medicare Part D program.

Other important Community Benefit Programs include:

- Providing better access to primary care providers
- Increasing access for women to receive basic screening exams
- Strengthening the local Emergency Medical Services volunteer program

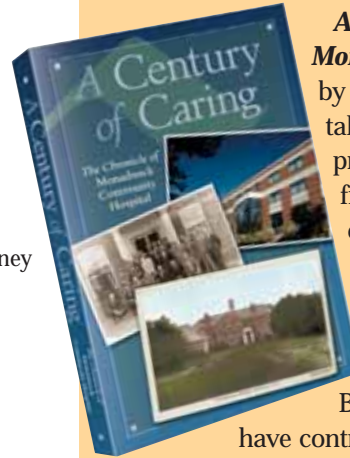

A Century of Caring... The Chronicle of Monadnock Community Hospital, written

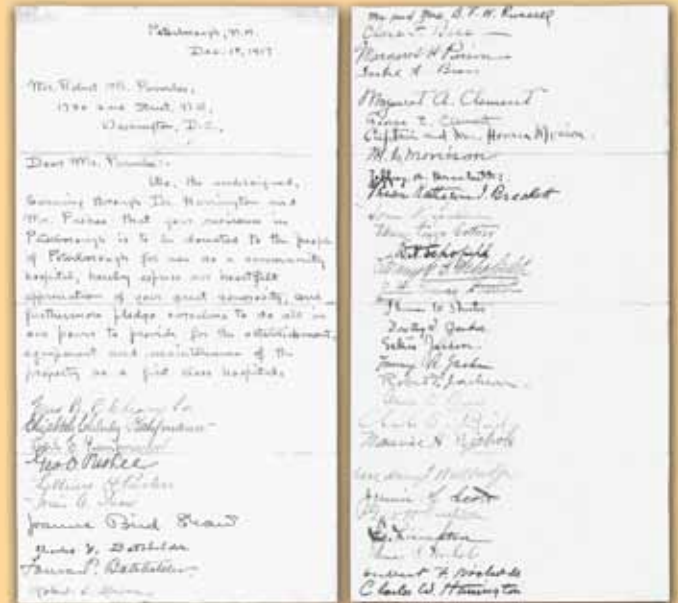

State of New Hampshire for a multi-phase expansion of the Hospital. The State gave its approval in April 2007. At the March 2007 Town Meeting, the Town of Peterborough voted to approve a new connector road linking Old Street Road and Route 202.

Beyond the physical expansion, MCH is committed to quality patient care, confidentiality and providing an environment of healing that promotes health and well-being.

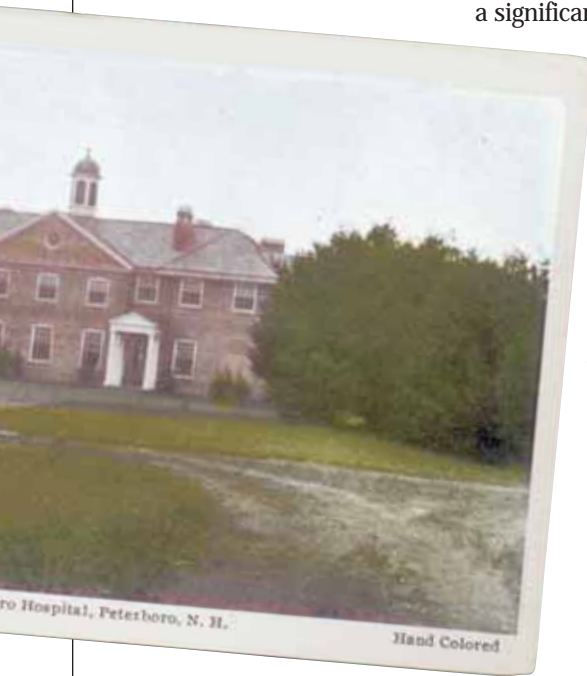

Charitable Gift Annuity – A Charitable Gift Annuity enables you to transfer personal assets such as cash or securities to Monadnock Community Hospital, which then pays you a fixed annual income that is guaranteed for life. It allows you to protect and increase your own financial security while making

a significant gift to the hospital. A Gift Annuity can be used to supplement retirement income. Annual income varies 6% to 10% depending on age of donor.

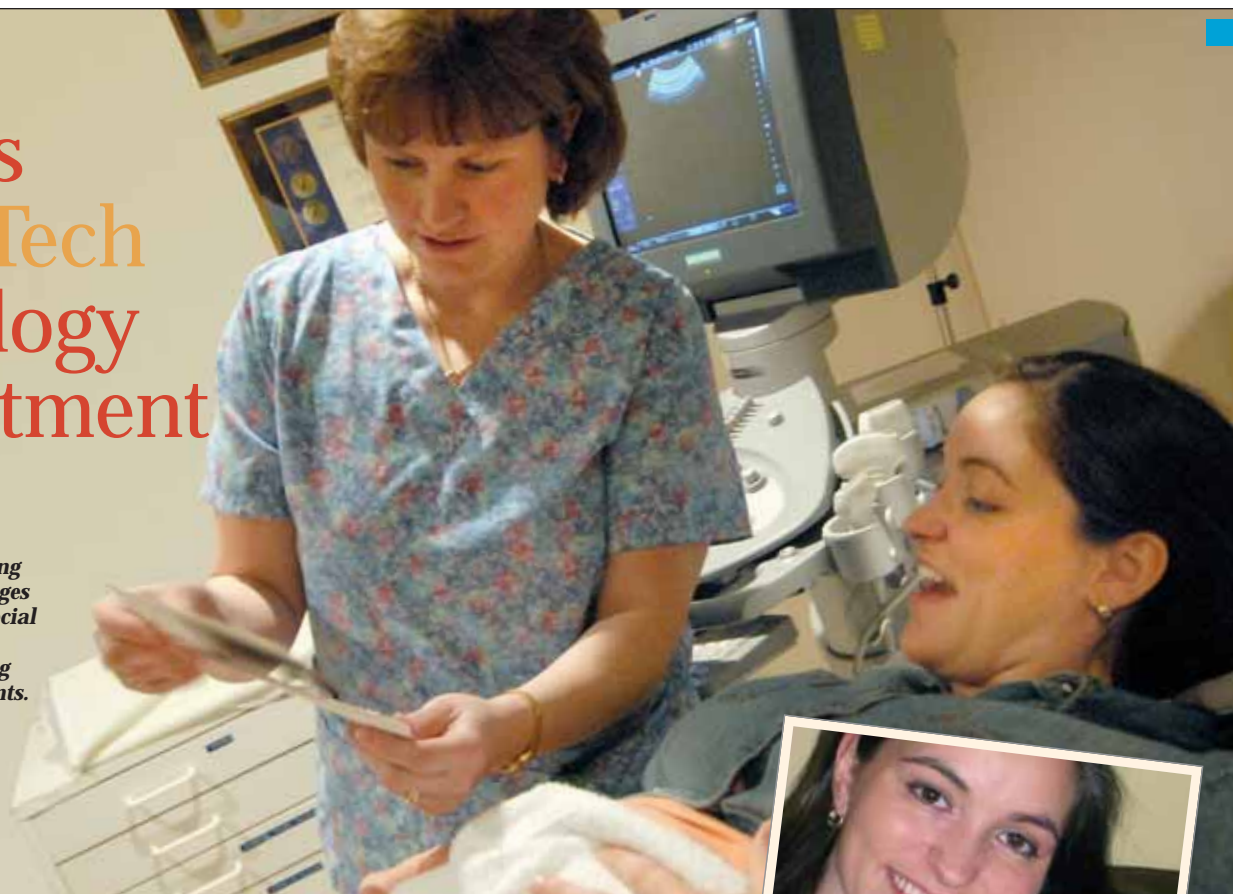

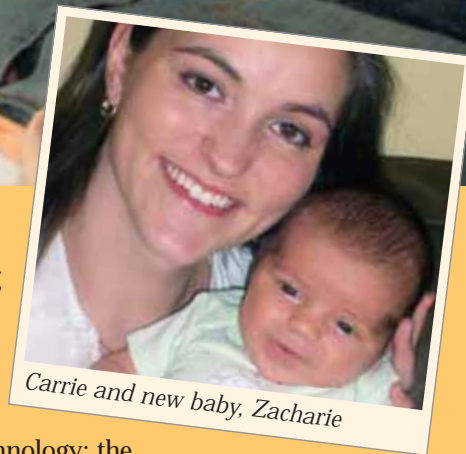


The Radiology Department at Monadnock Community Hospital has the same diagnostic imaging technologies and services that you would normally find in a much larger hospital. In fact, the equipment at MCH is often newer and more advanced. The highly skilled staff of 28 board-certified technologists offer 24-hour-a-day staffing with most results available within a day. In 2006, the Radiology Department performed 26,876 examinations.

In Spring 2006 the hospital acquired a hi-speed Toshiba 32-slice CAT scanner. This new scanner can acquire more anatomical slices because of new multi-slicing 3D imaging technology, and can be used to diagnose kidney, lung, liver, spine and blood diseases, cancer, tumors and cysts, as well as blood clots, hemorrhages and infections. Rounding out the

department's impressive imaging machines are two Siemens Ultrasound systems that provide 3D/4D technology; the very latest in mammography equipment; a GE Dual-Head Gamma Camera; and a MRI Scanner.

The Radiology Department offers patients in the Monadnock Region and beyond the most up-to-date imaging technologies available today, along with friendly service, appointment availability, and quick access to results for patients and doctors.

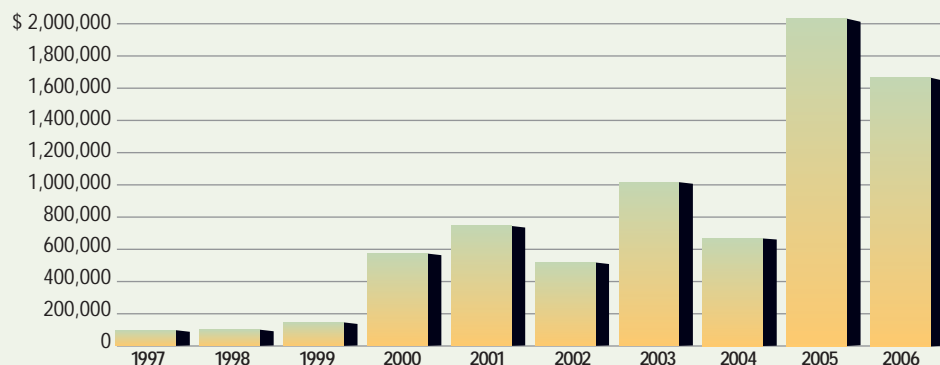

Emergency Department

With just under 13,000 visits in 2006, MCH's Emergency Department is by far one of the busiest departments in the hospital. With a staff of seven board-certified emergency physicians and 25 specialty nurses, patients entering MCH's Emergency Department can expect the same high quality emergency medical care that you would find in a larger hospital — without the long wait.

The majority of emergency medical issues can be treated at MCH. For those patients who need to be referred to a specialty hospital, MCH has developed an extensive network of working relationships with many specialty hospitals throughout northern New England. Many of the larger hospitals MCH utilizes, like the New England Heart Institute at Catholic Medical Center, have expertise and great reputations in specific specialties. Over the years MCH has expanded and developed relationships with larger, specialty hospitals to be able to offer the patient population the best possible care.



MCH participated in more than 75 helicopter transports to Level I Trauma Centers last year. Our affiliations with Level I Trauma Centers such as UMASS and Dartmouth-Hitchcock, ensure care for critically ill patients.
