

X-RAY ROOM 1933

The Hospital's first X-ray machine was purchased in 1926, representing a scientific leap forward in diagnosis. In 1933, on our tenth anniversary, Mrs. Carl Kaufmann donated the money needed to buy the latest, state-of-the-art X-ray equipment.



X-RAY ROOM 2023

Today's X-ray equipment produces instant, low-dose images that are immediately available to interpreting radiologists to expedite diagnosis and treatment.

The radiology department at MCH has expanded from a single X-ray machine to multiple X-ray suites, CT, Ultrasound, Mammography, MRI, and more.



Cause for Celebration

"We are here for you." These five words sum up the mission and promise of Monadnock Community Hospital and no one understands this more than Garry Peyton of Sharon. In 2022, after coming indoors from gardening, Garry found himself unable to form intelligible words. "I wasn't making sense," he recalls.

Suspecting a stroke, Garry's wife Julie rushed him to MCH where a brain scan confirmed her fears. Intravenous treatment was started immediately, and after a telehealth consultation in the Emergency Department with a stroke specialist, Garry's doctors decided to admit him overnight. When his symptoms returned the next morning, MCH clinicians were able to further connect with the stroke specialist and together decided to keep him another two days before he was stabilized for discharge. Garry left MCH with a referral for speech therapy to help with language issues he experienced as a result of his stroke.

"I had a very positive experience at MCH," Garry says, "especially with communication. Getting clear information is really critical in the ER because, as a patient, you're at a heightened level of concern, but my experience was ideal."

Reflecting on his own experience, and on the Hospital's 100-year milestone, Garry finds it "remarkable" that a small community like Peterborough has access to such a high level of care and technology.

"Technology has removed so many limitations for small hospitals like MCH," he notes. "It means that everyone in our community has access to top-notch care – and thanks to the expertise of the staff at MCH, I made a full recovery and feel great – that's definitely cause for celebration!"




100 Years of Helping Patients in Need

Providing care to patients without the means to pay has always been part of the MCH mission. In 1925, the Trustees voted to establish a fund expressly for "the care of children who may be identified as needy." Today, MCH's Community Benefit Program provides financial assistance to patients of all ages – patients like Francis Savoie.

Several years ago, Francis, a single dad who drove an oil truck for a living, was diagnosed with severe rheumatoid arthritis and degenerative disc disease. Suddenly, at the age of 42, he was permanently disabled. Francis was able to reduce his pain through regular infusion treatments at MCH's Oncology and Infusion Center, but his medical bills were a financial hardship.

"The infusion treatments really helped," he says, "but I had trouble affording my co-pays. MCH helped me through their Financial Assistance Program."

"The staff at MCH, they're good people," says Francis. "They fought for me, and never let me down. Disability is hard to accept, but the kindness and care I receive at MCH gives me the support and courage to go on."



ANESTHESIA 1963

The early years of the Hospital saw significant advances in the science of anesthesia, from the introduction of anesthesia machines in the 1930s to new, safer anesthetic drugs, devices that made intubation safer and more effective, and the introduction of the first intravenous anesthetics.



ANESTHESIA 2023

The team consists of four board-certified anesthesiologists that have the ability to provide ultrasound-guided nerve block and video capability for difficult intubation. They perform over 1,800 procedures in the OR each year.



You Don't Deserve to Live in Pain

After falling down a flight of stairs, Renee Deschuiteneer was left with pain in both her leg and hip. She coped with the pain as long as she could. However, things got worse to the point where she was forced to use her arms to lift her leg up into the car. At that point, Renee knew it was time to see an orthopaedic specialist.

Thankfully for Renee, her consultation was with MCH Orthopaedic Surgeon, Dr. Vache Hambardzumyan. After imaging Renee's leg and hip, Dr. Vache found extensive damage, including fractures in both her femur and hip.

Finally, there was an explanation for Renee's pain – and a solution.

Dr. Vache performed hip replacement surgery to fix Renee's hip, and also repaired her fractured femur and replaced missing bone.

"I love Dr. Vache," says Renee. "I felt like he understood my pain and anxiety. 'You've been through a lot,' he told me. 'You don't deserve to live in pain.' That meant a lot to me."

Following her surgery, Renee says she feels stronger than ever. She's looking forward to being active this summer. "I'm a young 62," she laughs, "and I'm ready to ride my bike again. The pain is gone."
































Thank You Employees, Past and Present




