

DISCRIMINATION IS AGAINST THE LAW

Nondiscrimination Provision of the Affordable Care Act, Section 1557

Monadnock Community Hospital ("MCH") complies with applicable Federal civil rights laws and does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, age, disability, or sex (consistent with the scope of sex discrimination described at 45 CFR § 92.101(a)(2)) which includes sex characteristics, intersex traits, pregnancy or related conditions, sexual orientation, gender identity, and sex stereotypes.
